With its departments and correctional facilities, the Office of Corrections of the Canton of Solothurn enforces criminal sanctions and supports the individual social reintegration of convicted offenders in a risk- and resource-oriented manner.

The Department for the Execution of Sentences and Measures (SMV) with its four teams ensures case management in the (early) execution of (substitute) custodial sentences pronounced by cantonal and federal criminal authorities (incl. special forms of execution such as electronic monitoring, semi-detention, community service) and (outpatient as well as inpatient) measures, of directives (activity, rayon and contact bans) as well as substitute measures under criminal procedure.

In the course of execution, it makes the necessary, suitable and appropriate execution decisions in a timely manner (from the choice of a suitable institution and any compulsory medication to conditional and final release), submits applications within the scope of the powers conferred by law on the courts, represents the canton of Solothurn in independent post-trial proceedings before cantonal courts and appellate bodies, and conducts detention proceedings where necessary.
